# (17:07) Neutron X-Ray Scattering School

- This year, there will be separate neutron and x-ray schools. The neutron school will take place the week of 8 September and the x-ray school will take place in July.
- The ORNL/neutron part of the school is planning on asking the same people as previous years to do the same lectures to try to preserve the format and content from previous years.
- The SHUG letter draft to DOE needs to be revised to instead emphasize supporting keeping the neutron and x-ray components of the school together to support combining the two communities and to educate future neutron and x-ray facility users.
- Survey of NXS Alumni:
  - 110 responses so far.
  - Most responses are from recent years (75% are from the last three years) but there are some responses from 2008 participants.
  - After the school, 58% participated in neutron experiments and 55% participated in x-ray experiments.
  - Actionable Item: Go through the survey responses to check for appropriate and relevant comments, and to attach the comments to the letter (Ben, Allen, and Weiwei volunteered).
- The plan is to finish up the letter and send to the SHUG and APS communities to get digital signatures.
- Actionable Item: Finalize the letter within the next week and have the SHUG-EC make final edits/comments.

# (17:16) Planning User Meeting (Joint with CNMS)

- Hillary, Ben, Weiwei, and Nariti are on the planning committee.
- Need to identify 2-3 plenary speakers by the next meeting on 21 February.
- Plenary speakers do not need to be from a specific subfield; the goal is to have neutron talks that can reach a wider audience; Ben suggested Simon Billinge.
- Sharing a list of previous speakers would be helpful for suggesting speakers for this year.
- Actionable Item: Send plenary speaker suggestions to Hillary (and can also send parallel session speaker suggestions).

- Meeting will be at the Crowne Plaza in Nashville, TN on 11-14 August; workshops will be held Monday and Thursday with the remainder of the meeting on Tuesday and Wednesday.
